HOUSE BILL 1624

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE LAW PERMITTING THE TAKING OF CATFISH AND
EELS IN TRAPS FROM THE HIGHWAY 258 BRIDGE TO THE
OCCONEECHEE GUT IN NORTHAMPTON COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 1278 of the 1981 Session Laws is repealed.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
