1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE COVERAGE OF INTERSTATE INTERCHANGE
3 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ZONES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 18B-1006(m) reads as rewritten:

6 "(m) Interstate Interchange Economic Development Zones. – The Commission
7 may issue permits listed in G.S. 18B-1001(10), without approval at an election, to
8 qualified establishments defined in G.S. 18B-1000(4), (6), and (8) located within one
9 mile of an interstate highway interchange located in a county that:

10 (1) Meets all of the following requirements:

11 a. Has approved the sale of malt beverages, unfortified wine, and
12 fortified wine, but not mixed ~~beverages;~~ beverages.

13 ~~(2)-~~b. Operates ABC ~~stores;~~ stores.

14 ~~(3)-~~c. Borders on another ~~state;~~ and state.

15 ~~(4)-~~d. Lies north and east of the Roanoke River.

16 (2) Meets all of the following requirements:

17 a. Has approved the sale of malt beverages, unfortified wine, and
18 fortified wine, but not mixed beverages.

19 b. Contains one city that has approved the sale of malt beverages,
20 unfortified wine, fortified wine, and mixed beverages.

21 c. Operates ABC stores.

1 d. Lies south and west of the Roanoke River and shares a common
2 border with a county qualifying in subdivision (1) of this
3 subsection.

4 (3) Contains an Economic Development and Tourist District described in
5 subsection (1) of this section."

6 Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
