A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FREE DRIVERS, HUNTING, AND FISHING LICENSES  
FOR CERTAIN DISABLED VETERANS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 20-7 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:  
"(q) Notwithstanding the fee schedules in subsection (i) of this section, the Division shall issue Class C drivers licenses without charge to any qualified disabled war veteran who is seventy percent (70%) or more disabled due to a service-connected disability as determined by the Veterans Administration."

Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1997.
