A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE AUTISM FOUNDATION OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR THE COMPLETION OF SEVERAL CAPITAL PROJECTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Autism Foundation of North Carolina, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of three million four hundred thirty-nine thousand two hundred seventy-five dollars (\$3,439,275) for the 1997-98 fiscal year for the completion of the following capital projects:

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
