**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO DIRECT THE CHILD FATALITY TASK FORCE TO STUDY BICYCLE SAFETY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The North Carolina Child Fatality Task Force shall study whether children under the age of 16 years should be required to wear safety helmets when riding bicycles. The Task Force may report its findings and recommendations, including recommended legislation, to the 1997 General Assembly, Regular Session 1998, and shall make a final report to the 1999 General Assembly, upon its convening.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
