A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO ESTABLISH DEADLINES FOR THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS
TO PROMULGATE RULES FOR A COMPUTERIZED VOTER REGISTRATION
SYSTEM AND FOR THE COUNTY BOARDS OF ELECTIONS TO COMPLY
WITH THOSE RULES.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The State Board of Elections shall promulgate rules by January 1, 1998, for the development and administration of a statewide computerized voter registration system as provided in Section 13.2(a) and (b) of Chapter 507 of the 1995 Session Laws. Those rules shall include standards with which counties shall comply. All county boards of elections shall comply with those rules by July 1, 1998.

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
