A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW ABSENTEE VOTING IN LAURINBURG CITY ELECTIONS
CONDUCTED BY THE MUNICIPAL BOARD OF ELECTIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Charter of the City of Laurinburg, being Chapter 586, Session
Laws of 1989, is amended by adding a new section to read:

"Sec. 4-2. **Absentee Voting.** Absentee voting shall be allowed in the City of
Laurinburg if city elections are conducted by a municipal board of elections, and any
references in G.S. 163-302 and Articles 20 and 21 of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes
that refer to the county board of elections shall, for the City of Laurinburg, refer to the
municipal board of elections if city elections are conducted by a municipal board of
elections. The State Board of Elections may adopt rules to regulate this section."

Section 2. This act becomes effective with respect to all elections held on or
after January 1, 1999.
