A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REVISE THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERS OF
THE LOCAL BOARDS OF TRUSTEES FOR COMMUNITY COLLEGES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 115D-12(b1) reads as rewritten:

"(b1) No person who has been employed full time by the community college within the prior 5 years and no ~~spouse~~ spouse, parent, parent-in-law, or child of a person currently employed full time by the community college shall serve on the board of trustees of that college. No member of the General Assembly shall be eligible for election or appointment as a trustee of a community college."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to terms beginning on or after that date.
