A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA INSTITUTE OF
MEDICINE.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the North Carolina Institute of Medicine the sum of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for operating costs and general support of the Institute's efforts to study and prepare reports to the General Assembly and the Executive Branch on health policy issues of concern to North Carolinians.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
