A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CABARRUS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL MAY AWARD A BACCALAUREATE OR ADVANCED DEGREE TO GRADUATES OF ITS NURSING AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES PROGRAMS AS APPROPRIATE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 11 of Chapter 307, Public-Local Laws of 1935 as amended by Chapter 947 of the 1987 Session Laws is amended by rewriting that section to read:

"Sec. 11. The ~~executive committee~~ Executive Committee of Cabarrus Memorial Hospital may establish and maintain in connection ~~therewith~~ with and as a part of ~~said the~~ hospital ~~a training school for nurses.~~ an educational program for nursing and allied health sciences. The Executive Committee may award an Associate ~~Degree~~ Degree, Baccalaureate Degree, or advanced degree to graduates of the nursing education ~~program~~ or allied health sciences programs as appropriate."

Section 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
