**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL RESOURCES FOR TRYON PALACE HISTORIC SITES AND GARDENS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of one million six hundred thirty-seven eight hundred fifty dollars (\$1,637,850) for the 1998-99 fiscal year for Tryon Palace Historic Sites and Gardens. Of those funds:

(1) \$332,850 shall be used to operate and maintain the Barbour Boat Works site until demolition and construction work at the site are completed;

and

(2) \$1,305,000 shall be used for the environmental assessment and design of the overall History Education Center Project.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1998.
