1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT GREYHOUND RACING IN NORTH CAROLINA.  
3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 Section 1. Article 37 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by  
5 adding a new Part to read:

6 **"PART 3. GREYHOUND RACING.**

7 **"§ 14-309.20. Greyhound racing prohibited.**

8 (a) No person shall hold, conduct, or operate any greyhound races for public  
9 exhibition in this State for monetary remuneration.

10 (b) No person shall transmit or receive interstate or intrastate simulcasting of  
11 greyhound races for commercial purposes in this State.

12 (c) Any person who violates this section shall be guilty of a Class 1  
13 misdemeanor."

14 Section 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1997, and applies to  
15 offenses committed on or after that date.
