A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
FOR RESEARCH AND DEMONSTRATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL FARMING
TECHNIQUES AT THE CENTER FOR ENVIRONMENTAL FARMING
SYSTEMS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture the sum of one million one hundred seventy-five thousand two hundred eighty dollars (\$1,175,280) for the 1997-98 fiscal year and the sum of one million three hundred forty-one thousand six hundred fifty-five dollars (\$1,341,655) for the 1998-99 fiscal year to support research and demonstration of environmental farming techniques at the Center for Environmental Farming Systems at the Cherry Farm Unit in Goldsboro.

Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997.
