A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE NORTH CAROLINA WOMENWORK FUND FOR
2 DISPLACED HOMEMAKERS TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE NORTH
3 CAROLINA COUNCIL FOR WOMEN, AND TO ESTABLISH AN ADDITIONAL
4 CIVIL ACTION FEE TO BE COLLECTED BY THE COURT IN DIVORCE
5 ACTIONS.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 Section 1. Part 10B of Article 9 of Chapter 143B of the General Statutes is
9 amended by adding the following new section to read:

10 "**§ 143B-394.10. North Carolina WomenWork Fund for Displaced Homemakers.**

11 (a) There is established in the Department of Administration the North Carolina
12 WomenWork Fund for Displaced Homemakers. The Fund shall be administered by the
13 Council in accordance with Article 1 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes and shall be
14 used to make grants to programs for displaced homemakers. The Council shall make
15 quarterly grants to each eligible program. Grants shall be awarded according to criteria
16 established by the Council. No more than ten percent (10%) of these funds shall be used
17 for administrative costs by the Council. In order to be eligible to receive grant funds
18 under this section, a displaced homemaker program shall fulfill all of the criteria
19 established by the Council. The Council shall report annually to the Joint Legislative

1 Commission on Governmental Operations on the revenues credited to the Fund, the
2 programs receiving grants from the Fund, the success of those programs, and the costs
3 associated with administering the Fund.

4 (b) The Department, upon recommendations by the Council, shall adopt rules to
5 implement the North Carolina WomenWork Fund for Displaced Homemakers."

6 Section 2. G.S. 7A-305 is amended by adding the following new subsection to
7 read:

8 "(a2) In every final action for divorce filed in the district court, a cost of twenty
9 dollars (\$20.00) shall be assessed against the person filing the divorce action. Costs
10 collected by the clerk pursuant to this subsection shall be remitted to the State Treasurer
11 for deposit to the North Carolina WomenWork Fund for Displaced Homemakers
12 established under G.S. 143B-394.10. Costs assessed under this subsection shall be in
13 addition to any other costs assessed under this section."

14 Section 3. G.S. 7A-305(c) reads as rewritten:

15 "(c) The clerk of superior court, at the time of the filing of the papers initiating the
16 action or the appeal, shall collect as advance court costs, the ~~faelilities fee and General Court~~
17 ~~of Justice fee, facilities fee, General Court of Justice fee, and the divorce fee imposed~~
18 under subsection (a2) of this section, except in suits by an indigent. The clerk shall also
19 collect the fee for discovery procedures under Rule 27(a) and (b) at the time of the filing
20 of the verified petition."

21 Section 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1997, and applies to final actions
22 for divorce filed on and after that date.
