**EFFECTIVE DATE:** When it becomes law.

**BILL SUMMARY:** Provides that the Civil Service Board for the City of Charlotte will be composed of five members and two alternates. Requires that termination hearings for police officers and firefighters be heard by a panel of five board members (any combination of available members or alternates) and suspension hearings be heard by a panel of three board members (any combination of available members or alternates).<sup>1</sup>

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:**

Assume that bill only changes composition of board members from “five members”... to “five members and two alternates....”. No other changes contained in the legislation would appear to require General Fund resources, beyond currently budgeted levels, for the City of Charlotte.
