April 1, 1999 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL RESOURCES FOR CULTURAL, HISTORICAL, AND ARTISTIC GRANTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of eight million dollars (\$8,000,000) for the 1999-2000 fiscal year to provide grants-in-aid to nonprofit organizations, local governmental entities, and museums throughout the State for cultural, historical, or artistic projects. Grants shall be limited to amounts of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or less. Section 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1999.
