A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR  
3 PROGRAMS THAT MAY BE ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD OF  
4 GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND TO  
5 PROVIDE THAT ONE OF THOSE PROGRAMS SHALL BE AT NORTH  
6 CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL AND TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY AND  
7 ONE AT NORTH CAROLINA CENTRAL UNIVERSITY.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 116-74.21(b) reads as rewritten:

10 "(b) No more than ~~nine~~11 school administrator programs shall be established  
11 under the competitive proposal program. In selecting campus sites, the Board of  
12 Governors shall be sensitive to the racial, cultural, and geographic diversity of the State.  
13 Special priority shall be given to the following factors: (i) the historical background of  
14 the institutions in training educators; (ii) the ability of the sites to serve the geographic  
15 regions of the State, such as, the far west, the west, the triad, the piedmont, and the east;  
16 and, (iii) whether the type of roads and terrain in a region make commuting difficult. A  
17 school administrator program may provide for instruction at one or more campus sites."

18 **SECTION 2.** The Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina  
19 shall include the Master of School Administration program at North Carolina  
20 Agricultural and Technical State University in Greensboro and North Carolina Central  
21 University in Durham as two of the 11 school administrator programs established  
22 pursuant to G.S. 116-74.21.

23 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
