BILL SUMMARY: Modifies the requirement for the use of helmets by operators and passengers on motorcycles and increases the fee by \$2.00 on private motorcycle registrations that is used to provide funds for motorcycle safety courses at Community Colleges under the Motorcycle Safety Program established pursuant to G.S. 115-72D.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: As of July 1, 2000 there were 97,250 motorcycles registered in North Carolina. At an additional fee of \$2.00 per motorcycle the additional amount for the Motorcycle Safety Program will be \$145,875 for nine months of FY 2001-2002 and \$194,500 for the following full fiscal years.
