1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PROVIDE A SALARY SUPPLEMENT OF  
3 TWELVE PERCENT TO NATIONALLY CERTIFIED TEACHERS IN HIGH SCHOOL  
4 AUTOMOTIVE PROGRAMS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.(a)** A teacher in a high school automotive program who is certified as  
7 an instructor by the National Automotive Technicians Education Foundation (NATEF) shall  
8 receive an annual salary supplement of twelve percent (12%), paid on a monthly basis, in  
9 addition to the compensation provided for a teacher with his or her level of academic  
10 preparation.

11 **SECTION 1.(b)** The State Board of Education shall adopt rules for the provision  
12 of the salary supplement pursuant to this act that shall include a process by which a teacher  
13 may verify that:

- 14 (1) The teacher is still employed by a local school administrative unit as a  
15 full-time employee;  
16 (2) The required certification has been attained and has not lapsed; and  
17 (3) The teacher meets all the qualifications to work as a high school automotive  
18 teacher in this State.

19 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of  
20 Public Instruction the sum of nine hundred four thousand four hundred seventy-four dollars  
21 (\$904,474) for the 2009-2010 fiscal year and the sum of nine hundred four thousand four  
22 hundred seventy-four dollars (\$904,474) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to implement the  
23 provisions of this act.

24 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009.
