A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO EXEMPT SALES OF ITEMS SOLD PURSUANT TO A RECEIVERSHIP PROCEEDING OR TO AN ORDER OF FEDERAL BANKRUPTCY COURT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 105-164.13 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(72) Sales of items sold pursuant to a receivership proceeding held in accordance with Article 29A of Chapter 1 of the General Statutes or to an order of the United States Bankruptcy Court." SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2020, and applies to sales occurring on or after that date.
