2	AN ACT TO MAKE CHANGES TO MEDICAID AND NC HEALTH CHOIC
3	TELEMEDICINE AND TELEPSYCHIATRY POLICIES TO FACILITATE INCREASE
4	ACCESS TO SERVICES, EVOLVE WITH THE LATEST TECHNOLOGY, AND ALIG
5	WITH BEST PRACTICES.
6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) shall make
8	the following changes to the Medicaid and NC Health Choice Clinical Coverage Policy No. 11
9	Telemedicine and Telepsychiatry:
10	(1) DHHS shall reimburse for telemedicine and telepsychiatry services performe
11	in a recipient's home or delivered from a licensed practitioner's home.
12	(2) A referral shall not be required for the use of telemedicine or telepsychiate
13	services.
14	(3) The delivery of telemedicine or telepsychiatry over the phone or by video ce
15	phone shall be covered.
16	(4) A referring provider and a receiving provider shall be allowed to bill fe
17	facility fees related to the provision of telemedicine or telepsychiatry on the
18	same date of service.
19	(5) Telemedicine and telepsychiatry services shall not be subject to the exact sam
20	restrictions as face-to-face contacts. The clinical coverage policy shall be
21	updated to align the policy with best practices for telemedicine ar
22	telepsychiatry.
23	(6) All behavioral health providers who are directly enrolled as providers in the
24	Medicaid and NC Health Choice programs, including licensed profession
25	counselors, licensed marriage and family therapists, certified clinic
26	supervisors, and licensed clinical additions specialists, shall be included in the
27	coverage policy as providers who may bill Medicaid or NC Health Choice for
28	telemedicine and telepsychiatry services and as providers who may bill for
29	facility fee.
30	In addition to the changes to Clinical Coverage Policy No. 1H, Telemedicine ar
31	Telepsychiatry, DHHS is directed to expand the billing code set available for telemedicine ar
32	telepsychiatry to include most outpatient billing codes, including family therapy ar
33	psychotherapy for crisis. With the exception of family therapy, the expanded billing codes sha
34	not include group-type therapies.

1 SECTION 2. The Department of Health and Human Services shall submit to the 2 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services any waivers or amendments to the NC Medicaid State Plan necessary to implement this act. The changes required by Section 1 of this act shall be 3 effective after the completion of the process for amending policy that is required under 4 5 G.S. 108A-54.2. 6

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
