5	SI	ECTION 1. G.S. 136-27.1(b) reads as rewritten:
6	"(b) A	municipality with a population of greater than 10,000 shall pay a percentage of the
7	nonbetterment cost for relocation of water and sewer lines owned by the municipality and located	
8	within the existing State transportation project right-of-way that are necessary to be relocated for	
9	a State transportation improvement project. The percentage shall be based on the municipality's	
10	population, with the Department paying the remaining costs, as follows:	
11	(1) A municipality with a population of greater than 10,000, but less than 25,000,
12		shall pay twenty-five percent (25%) of the cost.
13	(2	A municipality with a population of 25,000 or greater, but less than 50,000,
14		than 100,000, shall pay fifty percent (50%) of the cost.
15	(3	A municipality with a population of 50,000 of 100,000 or greater shall pay
16		one hundred percent (100%) of the cost."
17	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
