2	AN ACT TO AMEND THE PERCENTAGE OF NONBETTERMENT COST PAID BY
3	MUNICIPALITIES FOR THE RELOCATION OF WATER AND SEWER LINES.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 136-27.1(b) reads as rewritten:
6	"(b) A municipality with a population of greater than 10,000 shall pay a percentage of the
7	nonbetterment cost for relocation of water and sewer lines owned by the municipality and located
8	within the existing State transportation project right-of-way that are necessary to be relocated for
9	a State transportation improvement project. The percentage shall be based on the municipality's
10	population, with the Department paying the remaining costs, as follows:
11	(1) A municipality with a population of greater than 10,000, but less than $\frac{25,000}{25,000}$ ,
12	50,000, shall pay twenty-five percent (25%) of the cost.
13	(2) A municipality with a population of $\frac{25,000}{50,000}$ or greater, but less than
14	<del>50,000, than 100,000, shall pay fifty percent (50%) of the cost.</del>
15	(3) A municipality with a population of 50,000 of 100,000 or greater shall pay
16	one hundred percent (100%) of the cost."
17	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
