The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1.(a) There is transferred from the General Fund to the State Capital and		
Infrastructure Fund a sum sufficient in nonrecurring funding for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.		
SECTION 1.(b) There is appropriated from the State Capital and Infrastructure Fund		
to the Office of State Budget and Management a sum sufficient in nonrecurring funding for the		
2020-2021 fiscal year to be allocated for the Dorothea Dix campus relocation project with the		
Department of Health and Human Services.		
S	ECTION 2.(a) The provisions of the State Budget Act, Chapter 14	43C of the
