SENATE BILL 805

Short Title: Capital Appropriation - Raise the Age/DPS. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO FUND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AT DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY
FACILITIES IMPLEMENTING RAISE THE AGE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1.(a) There is transferred from the General Fund to the State Capital and Infrastructure Fund a sum sufficient in nonrecurring funding for the 2020-2021 fiscal year.

SECTION 1.(b) There is appropriated from the State Capital and Infrastructure Fund to the Office of State Budget and Management a sum sufficient in nonrecurring funding for the 2020-2021 fiscal year to be allocated for the following projects at the Department of Public Safety in the following amounts:

- (1) A sum sufficient for the Perquimans Youth Detention Center for Raise the Age renovations.
- (2) A sum sufficient for juvenile detention beds in Moore County.
- (3) A sum sufficient for completing construction of the Youth Detention Center in Rockingham County.

SECTION 2.(a) The provisions of the State Budget Act, Chapter 143C of the General Statutes, are reenacted and shall remain in full force and effect and are incorporated in this act by reference.

SECTION 2.(b) Except where expressly repealed or amended by this act, the provisions of any other legislation enacted during the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly expressly appropriating funds to an agency, a department, or an institution covered under this act shall remain in effect.

SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2020.
