5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:			
6		TION 1. Notwithstanding Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the General Statutes,		
7	any executive order, secretarial order, or directive authorized pursuant to Article 1A of Chapter

9	<i>p</i> provide bus transportation to students for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year as follows:			
10	(1)	For students receiving Plan A instruction, bus transportation shall be provided		
11		in accordance with the Plan A requirements for transportation established in		
12		the StrongSchoolsNC Public Health Toolkit (K-12) issued on March 4, 2021.		
13	(2)	For students receiving Plan B instruction, bus transportation shall be provided		
14		in accordance with the Plan B requirements for transportation established in		
15		the StrongSchoolsNC Public Health Toolkit (K-12) issued on March 4, 2021,		
16		except as provided in subdivision (3) of this section.		
17	(3)	Local boards of education offering Plan B instruction to students in grades six		
18		through 12 may offer transportation to those students in accordance with the		
19		Plan A requirements for transportation established in the StrongSchoolsNC		
20		Public Health Toolkit (K-12) issued on March 4, 2021. These local boards		
21		shall notify the Department of Health and Human Services and describe the		
22		unit's plan for providing transportation in Plan A. These local boards are		
23		authorized to share any information regarding the transportation provided in		
24		Plan A requested by the ABC Science Collaborative of the School of Medicine		
25		at Duke University (ABC Collaborative). The ABC Collaborative may		
26		provide analysis of this data.		
27	(4)	In the event a single bus simultaneously provides transportation to students		
28		receiving Plan A instruction and to students receiving Plan B instruction,		
29		except as provided by subdivision (3) of this section, the requirement that no		
30		more than one passenger may be seated per school bus bench seat shall apply		
31		only to those students receiving Plan B instruction.
