The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
<b>SECTION 1.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of		
Health and Human Services, Division of Central Management and Support, the sum of two		
million dollars (\$2,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2021-2022 fiscal year, to be allocated		
equally among the following health centers, to be used to fund programs or initiatives targeting		
racial and ethnic health disparities in diabetes, high blood pressure, and health conditions		
attributed to food insecurity:
