The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
SECTION 1. G.S. 14-208.16(a) reads as rewritten:		
"(a) A registrant under this Article shall not knowingly reside within 1,000 feet of any		
point of the property line or lines of the property on which any public or nonpublic school or		
child care center is located. This subsection applies to any registrant who did not establish his or		
her residence, in accordance with subsection (d) of this section, prior to August 16, 2006."		
SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to all persons		
registered or required to register on or after that date. This act does not apply to a person who has		
established	a residence prior to the effective date of this act in accord	ance with
