7	"§ 90-413. Willful destruction, alteration, or falsification of medical records.			
8			se. – It is unlawful for a health care provider to knowingly and willfully destroy,	
9	alter, or fals	lter, or falsify a medical record for any of the following purposes:		
10	<u>.</u>	<u>(1)</u>	Concealing the commission of an error by the health care provider in	
11			providing medical services that caused injury to or the death of a patient.	
12		<u>(2)</u>	<u>Unlawfully obtaining money or any other thing of value.</u>	
13	<u>!</u>	<u>(3)</u>	Concealing any material fact not covered under subdivision (1) of this	
14			subsection relating to a potential claim or cause of action.	
15		<u>Punishment.</u> – Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law

17	<u>follows:</u>			
18	<u>.</u>	<u>(1)</u>	A violation of subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of this section is a Class H	
19			felony.	
20	<u>.</u>	<u>(2)</u>	A violation of subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of this section is a Class I

24			Remedies. – Nothing in this section shall affect any civil remedies available for	
25	actions punishable under this section."			
26	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2023, and applies to offenses			
27	committed on or after that date.			



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
