| 13 | University of North Carolina. By March 1, 2023, the Board of Governors of The University of | |
| 14 | North Carolina shall report to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee on the results | |

| 16 | (1) The advantages and disadvantages of incorporating computer science into the | |
| 17 | minimum course requirements for admission. | |

| 20 | (3) Any decision made related to incorporating computer science into the | |
| 21 | minimum course requirements for admission. If no decision has been made, | |

| 23 | (4) The rationale for any decision made, including the rationale for the time line | |
| 24 | if a decision has not been made. | |
