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Short Title: Make North Carolina Home Act of 2023. (Public) Representative Moss. Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO TRANSLATE THE NORTH CAROLINA STATE BUILDING CODE INTO SPANISH; TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO ESTABLISH A WEBSITE TO TRACK ALL LOCAL PLANNING, ZONING, AND LAND-USE REGULATIONS; AND TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO DEVELOP A PROGRAM TO PARTNER WITH COUNTIES ON RESIDENTIAL SITE SELECTION. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 143-138(g) reads as rewritten: Publication and Distribution of Code. – The Building Code Council shall cause to be printed, after adoption by the Council, the North Carolina State Building Code and each amendment thereto. After the Building Code Council adopts the North Carolina State Building Code, the Council shall cause the Code and each amendment thereto to be printed in English and to be translated into Spanish. It shall, at the State's expense, distribute copies of the Code and each amendment to State and local governmental officials, departments, agencies, and educational institutions, as is set out in the table below. It shall also make the translated Spanish copies of the Code available for distribution on written request to the Council. (Those marked by an asterisk will receive copies only on written request to the Council.) 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SECTION 5. Section 1 of this act becomes effective January 1, 2025. Section 3 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2023. Section 4 of this act becomes effective August 1, 2023. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
