1 **SECTION 1.(b)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 2 Health and Human Services, Division of Aging and Adult Services, the sum of two hundred fifty 3 thousand dollars (\$250,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2023-2024 fiscal year and the sum of 4 two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2024-2025 fiscal 5 year to implement subsection (a) of this section.

6 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2023.
