The purpose of this Article is to codify the essential holdings of Roe v. Wade, 410 U.S. 113		
(1973), and Planned Parenthood of Southeastern Pennsylvania v. Casey, 505 U.S. 833 (1992).		
"§ 90-21.142. Allowable requirements.		
<u>(a)</u>	The State shall not impose an undue burden on the ability of a woman to ch	<u>ioose</u>
whether or not to terminate a pregnancy before fetal viability.		
·	The State may do any of the following:

<b>SECTION 2.</b> There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of State		
Budget and Management the nonrecurring sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the		
2023-2024 fiscal year to provide a grant to the North Carolina Obstetrical and Gynecological		
Society, a nonprofit corporation, to educate providers about the provisions of this act.		
<b>SECTION 3.</b> Section 2 of this act becomes effective July 1, 2023. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
