## SENATE BILL DRS15063-ND-59

Short Title: Add Members to NC Training Standards Commiss. (Public) Senators Jarvis, Hise, and Hanig (Primary Sponsors). Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ADD TWO NEW MEMBERS TO THE NORTH CAROLINA CRIMINAL JUSTICE EDUCATION AND TRAINING STANDARDS COMMISSION. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 17C-3(a) reads as rewritten: "§ 17C-3. North Carolina Criminal Justice Education and Training Standards Commission established; members; terms; vacancies. There is established the North Carolina Criminal Justice Education and Training (a) Standards Commission, hereinafter called "the Commission." The Commission shall be composed of 35-37 members as follows: At-large Groups. – One individual representing and appointed by each of the (4) following organizations: one mayor selected by the League of Municipalities; one law-enforcement training officer selected by the North Carolina Law-Enforcement Training Officers' Association; one criminal justice professional selected by the North Carolina Criminal Justice Association; one sworn law-enforcement officer selected by the North State Law-Enforcement Officers' Association; one member selected by the North Carolina Law-Enforcement Women's Association; and one District Attorney selected by the North Carolina Association of District Attorneys. Attorneys; one full-time sworn law-enforcement officer selected by the North Carolina Police Benevolent Association; and one member selected by the North Carolina Fraternal Order of Police. **SECTION 2.** As enacted by Section 1 of this act, the initial term of office for the member selected by the North Carolina Police Benevolent Association and the member selected by the North Carolina Fraternal Order of Police shall begin on July 1, 2023, and shall expire on June 30, 2026. Consistent with G.S. 17C-3(b), subsequent appointees to these positions shall be
