

1	"§ 105-543. Distribution and use.		
2	(a) <u>Distribution. – The Secretary shall, on a monthly basis, distribute to each taxing</u>		
3	municipality for which the Secretary collects the tax the net proceeds, as defined in G.S. 105-472,		
4	of the tax collected in that municipality under this Article. If the Secretary collects local sales		
5	and use taxes in a month and the taxes cannot be identified as being attributable to a particular		
6	taxing municipality, the Secretary shall allocate the taxes among the taxing municipalities in		
7	proportion to the amount of taxes collected in each municipality under this Article during that		
8	month and shall include them in the monthly distribution. Amounts collected by electronic funds		
9	transfer payments are included in the distribution for the month in which the return that applies		
10	to the payment is received.		
11	(b) Use. – A municipality may use the net proceeds of a tax levied under this Article for		
12	the purposes of public safety, economic development, and public facilities."		
13	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act applies to the Town of Rutherfordton only.		
14	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
