Whereas, bottlenose dolphins produce high-pitched clicks, called "echolocation," to		
help them navigate and find food; and		
Whereas, bottlenose dolphins can swim speeds of over 20 miles per hour, dive as deep		
as 800 feet below the surface, and can launch themselves up to 15 feet out of the water; and
