A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND WHAT CONSTITUTES THE CRIME OF FIRST DEGREE TRESPASS TO INCLUDE ENTERING OR REMAINING ON THE PREMISES OF ANOTHER BETWEEN THE HOURS OF MIDNIGHT AND 6:00 A.M.	
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 14-159.12(a) reads as rewritten: "(a) Offense. – A person commits the offense of first degree trespass if, without authorization, he enters or remains: the person does any of the following: (1) On-Enters or remains on the premises of another so enclosed or secured as to	

- demonstrate clearly an intent to keep out intruders; intruders.
- In Enters or remains in a building of another; or another. (2)

- On Enters or remains on the lands of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians 12 (3) after the person has been excluded by a resolution passed by the Eastern Band 13 14 of Cherokee Indian Tribal Council.
 - Enters or remains on the premises of another between the hours of midnight (4) and 6:00 A.M."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2023, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
