## SENATE BILL 246 Judiciary Committee Substitute Adopted 3/28/23

**Short Title:** Property Owners Protection Act. (Public) Sponsors: Referred to: March 9, 2023 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO AMEND WHAT CONSTITUTES THE CRIME OF SECOND DEGREE TRESPASS TO INCLUDE ENTERING OR REMAINING ON THE CURTILAGE OF A DWELLING BETWEEN THE HOURS OF MIDNIGHT AND 6:00 A.M. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-159.13 reads as rewritten: "§ 14-159.13. Second degree trespass. Offense. - A person commits the offense of second degree trespass if, without authorization, he the person enters or remains on premises of another: on any of the following: After he-On premises of another after the person has been notified not to enter (1) or remain there by the owner, by a person in charge of the premises, by a lawful occupant, or by another authorized person; or person. That-On premises that are posted, in a manner reasonably likely to come to (2) the attention of intruders, with notice not to enter the premises. On the curtilage of a dwelling of another between the hours of midnight and (3) 6:00 A.M. Classification. Second degree trespass is a Class 3 misdemeanor. Penalties. - A (b) violation of subdivision (a)(1) or (a)(2) of this section is a Class 3 misdemeanor. A violation of subdivision (a)(3) of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2023, and applies to offenses
