	not owned by a unit of local government, special district, or	r public authority,
	as those terms are defined in G.S. 159-7."	
<b>SECTION 1.(b)</b> G.S. 143-215.27 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:		
" <u>(e)</u> <u>T</u>	he Department shall not withhold approval of an application for r	epair or alteration
of a phased c	compliance eligible dam based solely on the fact that the repair or	alteration will not
fully meet th	he requirements of the Dam Safety Law of 1967 (Law) and	rules adopted to
implement the Law, provided the applicant meets all of the following conditions with respect to		
its proposed repair or alteration project:		
(1) The project will not increase the height or impoundment capacity of the dam.		
(2	The project will not increase the risk to human life or prope	ets, "

- (2) The project will not increase the risk to human life or property."
- **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to applications for repair or alteration received by the Department on or after that date.
