31	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding G.S. 143C-5-2, there is appropriated from the				
32	General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars				
33	(\$25,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2023-2024 fiscal year to implement the requirements of				
34	this act, including to fund the purchase of supplies for students to create displays or to fund the				
35	purchase of mounted plaques.				
36	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2023, and applies beginning with				
37	the 2024-2025 school year.
