A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE MAYOR OF CONETOE TO VOTE IN ALL MATTERS BEFORE  
THE BOARD.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 3.3.6 of the Charter of the Town of Conetoe, being Chapter 154 of the Private Laws of 1887, as amended, reads as rewritten:

"3.3.6 ~~Mayor Not to Vote:~~ Mayor's Voting Authority: The Mayor ~~shall not may~~ vote on any question before the ~~Board except in the case of a tie deadlocking decision of the Board of Commissioners.~~ Board."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
