9		(1)	"Records Records of criminal investigations" means all investigations. – All			
10			records or any information that pertains to a person or group of persons that is			
11			compiled by public law enforcement agencies for the purpose of attempting			
12			to prevent or solve violations of the law, including information derived from			
13			witnesses, laboratory tests, surveillance, investigators, confidential			
14			informants, photographs, and measurements. The term also includes any			
15			records, worksheets, reports, or analyses prepared or conducted by the North			
16			Carolina State Crime Laboratory at the request of any public law enforcement			
17			agency in connection with a criminal investigation.			
18		(2)	"Records Records of criminal intelligence information" means records			
19			information Records or information that pertain to a person or group of			
20			persons that is compiled by a public law enforcement agency in an effort to			
21			anticipate, prevent, or monitor possible violations of the law.			
22		(3)	"Public Public law enforcement agency" means a agency. – A municipal			
23			police department, a county police department, a sheriff's office, a company			
24			police agency commissioned by the Attorney General pursuant to G.S. 74E-1,			
25			et seq., and any State or local agency, force, department, or unit responsible			
26			for investigating, preventing, or solving violations of the law.			
27		(4)	"Violations Violations of the law" means crimes law. – Crimes and offenses			
28			that are prosecutable in the criminal courts in this State or the United States			
29			and infractions as defined in G.S. 14-3.1.			
30		(5)	"Complaining witness" means an Complaining witness. – An alleged victim			
31			or other person who reports a violation or apparent violation of the law to a			
32			public law enforcement agency.			
33		<u>(6)</u>	Booking photograph. – An image of an individual taken by an arresting public			
34			law enforcement agency for the purpose of identification or taken when the			
35			individual was processed into a jail.

(n) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and except as otherwise provided in this subsection, booking photographs are confidential, are not public records as defined in G.S. 132-1, and public law enforcement agencies are prohibited from publishing, distributing, or releasing booking photographs. A public law enforcement agency may release a booking photograph only when the booking photograph is a record of criminal investigation related to a missing person report. A court of competent jurisdiction may order the release of a booking photograph upon a showing by the person requesting disclosure that the disclosure is actually necessary for immediate law enforcement needs."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2025.
