16 17 The following definitions apply in this Chapter:

- Business contract. A contract or undertaking, contingent or otherwise, entered into primarily for business or commercial purposes. The term does not include a consumer contract or an contract, employment contract, or government contract.
- Government contract. A contract or undertaking, contingent or otherwise, to <u>(4)</u> which the State of North Carolina or a county, municipality, or other public body of the State of North Carolina is a party."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to contracts entered into, renewed, or amended on or after that date.
