A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REIMBURSE PRIVATE ENTITIES FOR INPATIENT TREATMENT SERVICES PERFORMED ON BEHALF OF CLIENTS UNDER A COMMITMENT ORDER AND EXTENDING BEYOND THIRTY DAYS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Article 4 of Chapter 122C of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 122C-146A. Reimbursement for extended inpatient treatment.

An LME or LME/MCO, as appropriate, shall reimburse the costs incurred by private entities

a commitment order."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to treatment by private entities beginning on or after that date.
